


*All families outside New England must call the office to inform us whether your son will be delivered to camp by parents or will need airport transportation.

## *Important* Travel Update



Dear Parents,

Due to current world affairs we must be very careful in our airport travel arrangements. With increased security we are no longer able to guarantee that we will be able to pass the security checkpoint and meet your child as he is coming off the plane. Therefore we must ask that all campers, regardless of age, fly as unaccompanied minors. This insures that your son will never be alone in the airport and is delivered only to the designated counselor from Camp Bournedale.

We ask that you make reservations as soon as possible and then contact Darin at the Bournedale office at 508-888-5442 or email us at [bournedale@comcast.net](mailto:bournedale@comcast.net). (Remember campers flying in for **first** session arrive one day early, Saturday June 27)(Campers coming in second session should arrive on Monday July 27). Once I have this flight information I will be able to tell you who will be picking up your son. Then you will be able to contact your airline and request that your son to be changed to unaccompanied minor status. We realize that this is an additional cost, however, after talking with representatives from Logan Airport as well as the individual airlines we feel this is the only way to guarantee your son will have a smooth and safe travel experience.

Another change in policy is that in past years we have had specific flights from LaGuardia, Newark and Philadelphia. Most people preferred to use their own airlines. Now instead of specific flights we are only asking that the arrivals and departures from Logan Airport are within the hours of 11am and 3pm. **International** flyers will not be held to these hours.

It is very important that you are aware of your individual airlines policies concerning airport security and luggage restrictions. You may want to consider using UPS or Fed Ex to send sporting equipment or oversize luggage. Remember to send your luggage as "round trip" as we are not able to have your luggage picked up at the end of the session without you initiating transport. Please call me during regular office hours as soon as possible with arrangements or should you have any questions.
